MATH DEPARTMENT

For all math classes

- All students should have 1-2 packages of ruled paper
- Required Calculator for **Pre-Algebra, Algebra 1, and Geometry**: The required calculator is the TI-30X IIS scientific calculator. If students already own a substantially similar calculator, they can continue using it with teacher permission. However, students will not be allowed to use a TI-34 MultiView calculator (or equivalent) in class.
- Required Calculator for **Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, Advanced Functions and Modeling, Discrete Math, AP Statistics and AP Calculus AB/BC**: The required calculator is a TI-84, or TI-84 Plus calculators. The TI-89 is allowed only in Calculus AB/BC classes. If you are buying a new calculator you should buy one of these models. Again, if students already own an equivalent calculator, they can use it with teacher permission.
